Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2010 and 2011, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2008 and 2009 using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group³. Murrelets were detected as present at site 1 during one survey in 2008 and at sites 3, 7, and 8 during surveys in 2009. However behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed in sites 1, 3, 7, and 8. Murrelets

were detected as present at site 2 in 2008. During surveys in site 2 in 2009, there were several observations of marbled murrelets including subcanopy observations indicating occupancy. Murrelets were detected as present at site 5 in 2008. During surveys in site 5 in 2009, there was a single survey with subcanopy observations indicating occupancy. In addition, there were multiple surveys with presence detections in site 5 in 2009.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

As a result of subcanopy behaviors observed during surveys in sites 2 and 5 in 2009, a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) was established. Sale area 2 is within 0.25 miles of a MMMA.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect for the list of activities below that occur within 300 feet of a MMMA. The restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through August 5, and from August 6 through September 15 between two hours before sunset and two hours after sunrise unless otherwise approved by STATE.

- Felling
- Cable yarding
- Log loading
- Ground-based operations
- Non-project road and landing construction
- Use of vibratory rollers for road maintainence

Seasonal operating restrictions for tailholds will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually within a MMMA.

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for explosive use within ¼ mile of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2014. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2015.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2014.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
