Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. It does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2008 and 2009, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Surveys for northern spotted owls are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

The sale is within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. A Biological Assessment of the sale's impact on the activity center has been conducted. It concludes the Rapid Rewards sale, as currently proposed, will result in a low risk to continued occupancy and productivity of the owls occupying the site.
