#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls.

## **Survey Results**

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2010 and 2011, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup>. A Northern spotted owl was observed on one occasion in 2010. This observation was attributed to a known activity center within 1.3 miles of the timber sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

The sale is within 1.3 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. A Biological Assessment of the sale's impact on the activity center has been conducted. It concludes the Quines Run No. 2 sale, as currently proposed, is expected to have a low risk of negatively affecting the occupancy and productivity of the spotted owl site.

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys and activity center monitoring will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
