Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in areas I, II, and III. It does not contain potentially suitable habitat for murrelets.

Survey Results

Sale areas I, II, and III were surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2010 and 2011, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.
