Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. ### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. It does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

### **Survey Results**

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2011 and 2012, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup>. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. Surveys will be ongoing in 2013.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

#### **Operational Considerations**

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2013 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys scheduled for 2014 and 2015 are not required for this sale at this time.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2015. After the 2013 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2016.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2016.

#### **Future Survey Plans**

ODF plans to conduct spotted owl surveys in 2013 to extend the duration of the sale contract. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2014 and 2015.
