This sale is located within the historic Tillamook burn. By previous ODF policy, northern spotted owl surveys were not required. Current policy requires spot checks for certain sales within the Tillamook burn. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

Survey Results

Surveys for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets were not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

There are no operational considerations for T&E wildlife species for this sale at this time.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2013, 2014, and 2015. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
