HARVEST TYPE: Areas 1 and 3: Approximately 63 Acres of modified clearcut, removing approximately 32 MBF/acre of western hemlock, Sitka spruce, Douglas-fir and red alder.
Area 2: Approximately 70 acres of partial cut, removing approximately 10 MBF/acre of western hemlock, sitka spruce and red alder.
Area 4: Approximately 8 acres of "individual tree selection", removing approximately 15 MBF of red alder.
Area 5: Approximately 43 acres of partial cut, removing approximately 19 MBF/acre western hemlock, sitka spruce, Douglas-fir and red alder.
Areas 6 and 7: Approximately 10 acres of partial cut, removing approximately 22 MBF/acre of western hemlock and red alder.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: Timber Sale Areas can be accessed via Highway 53 near mile post 9 to the North Fork Nehalem Road, and then stay right and travel through the gate on North Fork Road. Travel approximately 4 1/2 miles and turn right onto Sweethome Creek road. Travel approximately 1/2 mile to Area 1.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

All felling must be completed by March 15, 2015 (Sections 2310, 2350, and 2355).

All projects must be completed by October 31, 2014 (Section 2620).

Operations may not begin until September 1, 2013 or until completion of NSO surveys.

Vibratory roller use, hauling, and road construction shall not be allowed from April 1 through August 5 and from August 6 through September 15 between two hours before sunset and two hours after sunrise within the seasonally restricted area shown on the Exhibit "A."

North Fork Road is gated, a key is required for access and is available at the Astoria District Headquarters.

Pulp removal is required if yarded to landing.

The information shown on the Exhibit A map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2011 and 2012 for all sites except Keesler View sites 6 & 7, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Marbled murrelets were detected as present during a single survey visit to Lower Rector site 1 and Donut Combo site 1 in 2011. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed. Station 2 in Lower Rector site 3 was found to be unnecessary for coverage and was not surveyed in 2012.

Surveys for marbled murrelets for Keesler View sites 6 & 7 were conducted in 2012 and are ongoing in 2013, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group. Marbled murrelets have not been detected to date. Surveys will conclude by August 5th, 2013.

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2011 and 2012, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{2,3}. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. No spotted owls have been found to date during spot check surveys in 2013.

Known T&E Resources

A spur road leading to sale areas 5, 6, and 7 runs through a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA). Road maintenance will occur on this road in the MMMA. No trees will be felled as part of this project work.

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be required for vibratory roller use and brushing from April 1 through August 5, annually for roads within 300 feet of a MMMA. Operations are allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2013 marbled murrelet surveys.

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2015. Marbled murrelet survey results for all sites except the Keesler view sites are valid until April 1, 2018.

Marbled murrelet survey results for the Keesler View sites will be valid until April 1, 2019 when the 2013 surveys have been completed.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2015.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Spotted owl spot check surveys for this sale will be conducted in 2014.
