#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in all sale areas and marbled murrelets in sale areas 1-6 and road segments 1, 3, and 4.

#### **Survey Results**

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2011and 2012 using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. Marbled murrelets were not detected during these surveys. There was a slight deviation from protocol regarding survey station sequencing in site 4 in 2011. However, since the site was able to be adequately covered by a single station the intent of the protocol sequencing was achieved.

A survey waiver for marbled murrelets has been issued for road segment 4 project work.

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2011 and 2012, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>2,3</sup>. Northern spotted owls were not

observed during these surveys. Surveys are ongoing in 2013 and are expected to be completed by August 31.

#### Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Sale areas 4 & 5 are within 1/4 of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area

#### **Operational Considerations**

Operations including timber felling, ground based operations, cable yarding operations, road construction, road improvement, and road vacating shall not be allowed from April 1 through September 15 within seasonally restricted areas.

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2013 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2015. After the 2013 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2016.

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2018.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2016.

## **Future Survey Plans**

ODF is currently surveying this sale for northern spotted owls. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2014 and 2015.
