## **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in all sale areas. It does not contain suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

## **Survey Results**

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2012 and 2013, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup>. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale. However, project work consisting of road brushing will occur adjacent to MMMA's.

## **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions will be required for road brushing activities from April 1 through August 5, annually for not commonly used roads within 300 feet of a MMMA's. Operations are allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2016.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2016.

#### **Future Survey Plans**

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2014 and 2015. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
