#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

#### Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2012 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup>. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. A 257 acre survey coverage gap in coverage occurred in 2012. To address this gap, a hypothetical owl resource site was utilized to conduct a Biological Assessment (BA) to analyze risk of take. The BA concludes that the likelihood of take of northern spotted owls is low. Surveys are ongoing in 2013 with no observations of spotted owls to date.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

#### **Operational Considerations**

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2013 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Spotted owl northern spotted owl survey results will be valid until March 15, 2016 once the 2013 surveys have been completed. .

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2016.

## **Future Survey Plans**

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2014 and 2015. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
