HARVEST TYPE: Area 1 is 76 net acres of modified clear cut, Area 3 is 41 acres of modified clear cut, Area 5 is 101 acres of modified clear cut, Area 7 is 75 acres of modified clearcut, Area 9 is 38 acres of modified clear cut and Area 11 is 103 acres of modified clear cut. Approximate age is 47 years.

SALE LOCATION: Portions of Sections 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 21, and 22, T2S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Tillamook go east on Third Street to the four way stop, turning right on Trask River Road, turn left in 1.5 miles continuing on Trask River Road and follow it 12 miles to the end of the pavement, cross bridge then travel 1.3 miles on South Fork Trask (gravel) past Hollywood OHV area to BSM Road; turn right on to BSM Road and go 1.7 miles to Area 1.

**ENDANGERED SPECIES
ACT COMPLIANCE
STATEMENT:**

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

POTENTIAL THREATENED & ENDANGERED SPECIES LAWSUIT: Be advised that a Notice of Intent to Sue the State of Oregon has been filed for this timber sale for alleged violation of Sections 4(d) and 9 of the federal Endangered Species Act, pertaining to federally listed Oregon Coast Coho Salmon on the Tillamook and Clatsop State Forests.

Section 2015, "Log Accountability"; 2020, "Log Measurement"; 2030, "log Branding and Painting"; and Exhibit C contain special language for pulp removal.

Sale acreage was determined using GIS.

Felling (Section 2310). All felling on the Timber Sale Area must be completed by March 15, 2018.

There is a permanent easement along SF Trask Road with Stimson Lumber: 311.29246. There is also a permit between Tillamook County and ODF, Non Utility Facility Permit, allowing ODF to maintain the SF Trask Road between where the gravel starts and Hollywood Camp: # 311.29494.

T & E Survey: The sale area will be surveyed for Northern Spotted Owl presence during 2015. To facilitate the survey operation, no timber harvest operations are allowed other than those associated with Project Work until either the survey is completed or August 31, 2015 whichever date occurs first.

The information shown on the Exhibit A map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2013. Surveys are ongoing in 2014 and will continue in 2015 to extend the contract felling date. Surveys have been conducted using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. Northern spotted owls were observed once in 2013. This observation was determined to be from a non-territorial single (or "floater") owl within 1.5 miles of the timber sale. There have been no observations of northern spotted owls to date in 2014.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2015 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2018.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2016 and 2017. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys and activity center monitoring may be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
