Habitat Suitability

This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

The Elliott State Forest is in a spotted owl density study area. There were three responses from northern spotted owls during surveys in 2012 and 2013. These observations were attributed to known activity centers greater than 1.5 miles of the timber sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

There are no operational considerations for threatened or endangered species associated with this sale.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans to survey this sale. However, ODF will conduct operational, density, and/or activity center monitoring surveys for northern spotted owls within 3 miles of this sale during the duration of the contract.
