Log truck and rock truck traffic, including empties, on mile 0.0 to 5.0 of the 1000 Road (Marlow Creek) is not allowed from October 15 through May 15 (Section 2130).

Cable Yarding Operations including locating of tailholds or stringing of cables shall not be allowed within any Logging Restricted Area or any Marbled Murrelet Management Area – Occupied Habitat (Section 2350).

Cable Yarding Operations and non-Project Roads and Landing Construction shall not be allowed from April 1 to August 5 within any Marbled Murrelet Management Area – Buffer. Furthermore, daily timing restrictions shall be in effect from August 6 to September 15 within any Marbled Murrelet Management Area – Buffer during which cable yarding and non-Project Roads and Landing Construction may be allowed from no earlier than two hours after sunrise until no later than two hours before sunset (Sections 2350, 2360).

If ground-based yarding equipment is selected for harvest operations, Purchaser shall wash equipment associated with ground operations for invasive plants and noxious weeds before operations begin (Section 2416).

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale is in an area covered by northern spotted owl density surveys in 2013 and 2014. The density surveys were conducted using a modified survey approach incorporating aspects of both the density survey protocol (Forsman 1995) and the USFWS-endorsed survey protocol for spotted owls (USFWS 2012)^{1,2}. Northern spotted owls were observed on three occasions in 2013 within 1.5 miles of the timber sale. All observations were attributed to known activity centers greater than 1.5 miles of the timber sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

This sale is within ¼ mile of an occupied marbled murrelet survey site.

Operational Considerations

Cable Yarding Operations including the establishment of tailholds, guyline anchors, or stringing of cables shall not be allowed within any Logging Restricted Area or any Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA).

Cable Yarding Operations shall not be allowed from April 1 through August 5 in any MMMA buffer. Furthermore, daily timing restrictions shall be in effect from August 6 through September 15 within any MMMA buffer during which cable yarding operations may be allowed from no earlier than two hours after sunrise until no later than two hours before sunset.

Non-Project Road and Landing Operations shall not be allowed from April 1 through August 5 within any MMMA buffer Additionally, daily timing restrictions shall be in effect from August 6 to September 15 within any MMMA buffer during which Non-Project Road and Landing Operations may be allowed from no earlier than two hours after sunrise until no later than two hours before sunset.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2017.

Future Survey Plans

ODF plans to continue spotted owl density surveys on the Elliot State Forest in vicinity of this sale. The continuing density survey coverage will be utilized in lieu of the spot check survey requirement. In the future, ODF will conduct density, operational, and/or activity center monitoring surveys for northern spotted owls within 3 miles of this sale during the duration of the contract.
