Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2012 and 2013, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Marbled murrelets were detected as present during four surveys in 2012 and one survey in 2013. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed at any site. A subcanopy observation outside of the survey site in 2012 was reviewed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and found not to be indicative of occupancy. The station array was slightly different between 2012 and 2013. However, complete coverage of the sight was achieved during both years of survey effort.

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2012 and 2013, using a protocol endorsed by the USFWS^{2,3}. A northern spotted owl was observed on one occasion in

2013. A northern spotted owl was observed on one occasion in 2014 as part of surveys for future operations. The resident status of these observations will be determined at the end of the survey season.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2016. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2019.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2016.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2015 and 2016 if timber felling has not been completed. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
