Cable Yarding Operations including locating of tailholds and guyline anchors or stringing of cables shall not be allowed within the Big Scholfield Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) – Occupied Habitat (Section 2350).

Cable Yarding Operations including locating of tailholds and guyline anchors or stringing of cables shall not be allowed within the Big Scholfield MMMA – Buffer without prior inspection and approval by STATE (Section 2350).

Cable Yarding Operations including locating of tailholds and guyline anchors or stringing of cables shall not be allowed from April 1 to August 5 within the Big Scholfield MMMA – Buffer or Seasonally Restricted Area. Furthermore, daily timing restrictions shall be in effect from August 6 to September 15 within the Big Scholfield MMMA – Buffer or Seasonally Restricted Area during which cable operations may be allowed from no earlier than two hours after sunrise until no later than two hours before sunset (Section 2350).

A radio tower is located near Point E. PURCHASER shall protect the radio tower, tower enclosure, and accessory structures (Section 2420).

Pulp removal is required if yarded to Landing.
