The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in sale areas 5–8. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2015 and 2016. Surveys have been conducted using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2} There were no observations of northern spotted owls in either 2015 or 2016. Surveys are planned for 2017 to extend the contract felling date.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2017 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Northern spotted owl survey results will be valid until March 15, 2020 upon the completion of 2017 surveys.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2020.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will occur in 2018 and 2019. In addition, ODF has an active northern spotted owl survey program and surveys for other planned operations will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
