### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in sale areas 1–2. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

### **Survey Results**

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2015 and 2016. Surveys have been conducted using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup> There were no observations of northern spotted owls in either 2015 or 2016. Surveys will be ongoing in 2017 to extend the contract felling date.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.
