#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest (SPSF), near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

### **Survey Results**

Northern spotted owl surveys are conducted as a component of the Forest Management Plan for SPSF. SPSF was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 1999/2000, 2005/2006, and 2012/2013 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup>. There were no responses from northern spotted owls during any year of survey.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

This sale is not affected by any known northern spotted owl activity centers.

There is a documented Bald Eagle nest site within ½ mile of the timber sale area. ODFW considers this to be a roadside nesting site that does not warrant seasonal restrictions.

## **Operational Considerations**

There are no operational restrictions for T&E species at this time.

## **Future Survey Plans**

ODF may conduct northern goshawk and woodpecker surveys in the vicinity of the sale during the life of the contract.
