Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

Survey Results

This sale was covered by operational surveys prior to 2018 and density surveys for northern spotted owls in 2018 using protocols endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2,}. Northern spotted owls were not observed within 1.5 miles of this sale in 2018.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Northern spotted owl survey results will not expire unless density surveys are discontinued. If density surveys are discontinued at any point during the contract, survey coverage will be valid until March 15, three years following the last full season of surveys.

Future Survey Plans

These sales will be covered by density surveys during the life of the contract. These density surveys provide incidental survey coverage in lieu of spot checks. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required. In addition, ODF has an active northern spotted owl survey program and density surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contracts. Spotted owl activity center monitoring may occur if the sale is within 3 miles of a known resident owl site.
