Habitat Suitability

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest near the eastern edge of the range of the northern spotted owl. This sale contains habitat suitable for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

By policy, no operational surveys are required for sales on Sun Pass State Forest. However, northern spotted owl surveys were conducted as a component of the Forest Management Plan for the Sun Pass State Forest in 1999/2000, 2005/2006, and 2012/2013 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. There were no responses from northern spotted owls during any year of survey.

Future Survey Plans

ODF will be conducting northern spotted owl surveys on Sun Pass State Forest in 2019. Northern goshawk surveys may also be conducted during the life of the contract.
