HARVEST TYPE: Roadside salvage along approximately 18 miles of forest road. Selected harvest of burned timber from the 2017 Chetco Bar fire covers approximately 200 acres.

SALE LOCATION: T38S, R11W, portions of Section 19 and T38S, 12W, portions of Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 27, and 34. US Forest Service Ownership.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Brookings, head up the Chetco River, following the 1376 road into the Rogue Siskiyou National Forest boundary. Proceed up the 1917 to the 060 road system.

HARVEST METHOD: Ground based and short cable yarding

PROJECTS: Project No. 1. Improve roads used during operations satisfying this contract by removing vegetation, sloughs, or other foreign material from the running surface.

Grade the running surface to achieve a smooth, crowned road. Ensure ditches are passable and culverts are clear. Roads used during this contract shown as "Purchaser Maintained" on Exhibit "A" will be required to be in a smooth, clean, running surface at the end of operations.

FEES: None

The undersigned understands that the bid is irrevocable and further agrees that if they fail to qualify under the terms of the contract within the thirty-day period, the bid deposit shall become the property of the Oregon Department of Forestry as liquidated damages. **If the undersigned fails to qualify within the thirty-day period, STATE may disqualify the undersigned from submitting another bid on this timber sale.**

- (a) Are not currently in default status under any timber sale contract sold by the State Forester.
