The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2018 and 2019. Surveys were conducted using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. There were no observations of northern spotted owls in either year of survey.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2018 and 2019, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group³. Marbled murrelets were detected as present at site TSF133-1 during two surveys in 2018. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed. Marbled murrelets were detected as present at site TSF133-2 during one survey in 2019. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Northern spotted owl survey results will are valid until March 15, 2022.

Marbled murrelet surveys are valid until April 1, 2025.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2022.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2020 and 2021. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys may be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
