Habitat Suitability

This sale is located in the Klamath-Lake District near the eastern edge of the range of the northern spotted owl. This sale contains habitat suitable for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

By policy, no operational surveys are required for sales in the Klamath-Lake District. However, northern spotted owl monitoring surveys were conducted as a component of the Eastern Region Long Range Forest Management Plan in 1999/2000, 2005/2006, and 2012/2013 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service 1,2. Surveys have recently been completed in 2018. There were no responses from northern spotted owls during any year of surveys.

ODF will be conducting northern spotted owl surveys on Sun Pass State Forest and Bear Valley tracts in 2019. Northern goshawk surveys may also be conducted during the life of the contract.
