Habitat Suitability

This salvage sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls due to a recent wildfire.

Survey Results

Northern spotted owl surveys are not required for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is within 1.3 miles of four northern spotted owl activity centers. A Biological Assessment of the sale's impact on the activity centers has been conducted. It concludes that the MP97 timber sale, as currently planned, poses low risk of negatively affecting the occupancy and productivity of the activity centers.

Future Survey Plans

Spotted owl activity center monitoring surveys may occur within 1.3 miles of this sale.
