The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract.
