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Cruise Report South Chicken Blowdown 343-14-703

Sale Area: A portion of T17S, R8W, Sec. 10 of the W.M. The gross and net acreage is 6 acres. Acres were determined by using a combination of aerial photos, GPS, GIS, and topographic maps.

Stand Description: Sale is a blown down stand of 75 year old Douglas-fir. Approximately half of the trees either blew over or are root sprung. The majority of the sale will require cable logging. The removal specs include all Douglas-fir that are blown down or are leaning more than 10 degrees from perpendicular.

Cruise Method: The Sale was not cruised. Volume is based off 40% of the actual volume from the adjacent stand. Adjacent stand (South Chicken Timbersale) cut out at 47 MBF/acre.

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
