Habitat Suitability

This sale does contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. Sale does not contain suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. Sale consists of trees blown over and leaning trees caused by 2013 winter storms. Canopy cover has been reduced below 50% in an area over 9 acres.

Survey Results

Surveys for northern spotted owls are not necessary for this sale.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were detected as present during one survey in 2008. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale. BLM has declared an occupied Marbled Murrelet site north of the timber sale.

Operational Considerations,

Felling and Yarding Operations within 300 feet of BLM shall not be allowed from April 1 through August 5, or from August 6 through September 15 between two hours before sunset and two hours after sunrise.

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2014.

All timber should be felled by November 30, 2013.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. In addition, the Bureau of Land Management will be conducting northern spotted owl surveys within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
