## **Biological Survey Report**

#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in sale areas 1 and 2. This sale is located in the Marbled Murrelet Systematic Survey Zone. By ODF policy, operational marbled murrelet surveys are not required.

### **Survey Results**

Adjacent sales in the area where surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2013 and 2014 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1,2</sup> providing incidental coverage for this sale until March 15, 2017. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

If the contract extends past March 15, 2017 a survey waiver for northern spotted owls has been issued for areas 1 and 2. The waiver finds that the two small areas of potentially suitable habitat may be harvested following appropriate protection parameters.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

### **Operational Considerations**

Survey results are valid until March 15, 2017.

If the timber is not felled in areas 1 and 2 by March 15, 2017 the following restrictions will take place as per the survey waiver:

 No habitat modification may occur during the period from March 16 through September 30.

#### **Future Survey Plans**

ODF has no plans to survey this sale. However, ODF has an active northern spotted owl survey program. Density surveys, spot checks, activity center monitoring, and surveys for other planned operations will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
