ACT COMPLIANCE to the federal and State Endangered Species Act. STATEMENT:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. Surveying efforts may take place in the Timber Sale Area anytime during the term of the Contract. Purchaser acknowledges that T&E survey work or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect PURCHASER's Operations under the Contract, and PURCHASER agrees to cooperate with STATE's survey work and other activities designed to identify and protect T&E species. In the event any T&E species is found within or in the vicinity of the Area(s) of Operations, or the State otherwise deems it necessary or expedient to take action in response to any pending or threatened legal action concerning State forest land or any T&E species, PURCHASER agrees that STATE may take steps to protect the interests of the State, including imposing restrictions on PURCHASER's Operations under the Contract to prevent disturbance to T&E species, including Contract modification, suspension, or termination.

PURCHASER also acknowledges that at some point during the Contract term, the STATE may also become subject to terms and conditions of Incidental Take Permits issued by the federal government covering State forest lands. PURCHASER agrees that any Operations that occur following issuance of an Incidental Take Permit, if any, must be carried out consistent with such terms and conditions that include required minimization and mitigation measures proposed in the applicable Habitat Conservation Plan, and PURCHASER further agrees that STATE may take steps to protect the interest of the State, including imposing restrictions on PURCHASER's Operations under the Contract to ensure such compliance, including Contract modification, suspension, or termination.

All pulp that is yarded to the landing shall be hauled. (Section 2045).

Wet season ground based logging will not be waived in portions of the harvest unit as shown on the logging plan.

A portion (<2 ac) of the sale Area is subject to seasonal operational restrictions as shown on Exhibit "A". (Section 2455).

During significant rainstorm events or if the road is showing signs of road failure, hauling will not be permitted. Significant rainstorm events are generally defined as periods when rainfall exceeds 1 1/2" in a 24-hour period or 2" in a 48-hour period, as measured at the nearest weather station as specified by STATE (Sections 1420 and 2130).

Habitat Suitability

This sale has potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. There is potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets within and adjacent to this sale.

Survey Results

This sale has been covered by northern spotted owl density surveys in 2023 and 2024¹,²,³. Northern spotted owls have not been observed within 1.5 miles of this sale during these surveys. An unknown Strix owl was observed within 1.5 miles on one occasion in 2023.

This sale, except for 1.4 acres covered under a survey waiver, was surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2020/2021 and 2023/2024. These surveys were conducted using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group⁴. Marbled murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

This sale is in a density survey coverage area. Northern spotted owl felling deadlines for survey expirations will not be in effect unless density surveys are discontinued. If density surveys are discontinued at any point during the contract, survey coverage will be valid until March 1, three years following the last full season of surveys.

Operations will not be permitted within the seasonal restriction area identified on Exhibit A during the period of April 1 - August 5. Harvest related activities are allowed with daily timing restrictions from August 6 - September 15.

Marbled murrelet surveys will be valid until April 1, 2027 for a portion of this sale. Marbled murrelet surveys will be valid until April 1, 2030 for the remainder of this sale.

All timber should be felled by the contract expiration date of 10/31/2026. If the contract is extended, additional early felling deadlines will apply.

Future Survey Plans

This sale will be covered by northern spotted owl density surveys during the life of the contract. These density surveys provide incidental survey coverage in lieu of spot checks. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and surveys for other planned operations, northern spotted owl density surveys and activity center monitoring will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
