Habitat Suitability

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest near the extreme eastern edge of the range of the northern spotted owl. This sale contains habitat suitable for northern spotted owls (NSO).

Survey Results

Protocol timber sale surveys for NSO are not required in the Klamath Lake District. In lieu of timber sale surveys, monitoring surveys are conducted every 5 years as per the Eastern Oregon Long Range Forest Management Plan. Surveys on Sun Pass State Forest were recently conducted in 2018 and 2019 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. There were no responses from northern spotted owls during any year of surveys. NSO protocol surveys are currently being conducted in 2024, and to date, there have been no responses.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is not affected by any known T&E or FPA wildlife resource sites. Northern goshawks have been known to nest within the sale boundary in the past. Working collaboratively with the district, harvest exclusion areas were identified to protect likely nesting habitat for future use by goshawks.

Operational Considerations

There are no operational restrictions for T&E species at this time.

Future Survey Plans

Northern goshawk and northern spotted owl surveys may be conducted during the life of the contract.
