DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Prineville head east on Highway 26 approximately 7 miles to NE Mill Creek Rd. Head North on Mill Creek Rd. for approximately 5 miles. Where Mill Creek Rd. turns to gravel, take an immediate left on NF Rd. 3370. Travel down NF Rd 3370 for ¼ of a mile and take a left on NF Rd 3380. Cross the bridge on NF Rd 3380 and travel for approximately 1.5 miles and the Timber Sale Area is along both sides of NF Rd 3380.
