ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state

Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

SPECIAL REMARKS:

NO PERSONAL OR COMPANY CHECKS ACCEPTED FOR THE BID DEPOSIT. SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SECTION 2455.

PULP REMOVAL IS OPTIONAL. UTILITY LOGS SHALL BE DECKED SEPERATELY AND MAY BE SHIPPED AS PULP AS APPROVED BY THE CONTRACT ADMINISTRATOR.

Any charred wood fiber can be bucked out of logs during the manufacturing process and will be left scattered in the units as down wood.

Purchaser may request up to a 1 year extension to an existing ODF sale or future ODF green timber sale, if purchased within 90 days of salvage sale. This is a one Santiam Salvage Sale for any one green timber sale regardless of volume or location. It does not apply to GNA sales that ODF administers for the USFS. . Sales that require T&E surveys will require a case-by-case analysis with the Division to ensure extension meets survey requirements. Purchasers can review the Biological Survey Report in their sold sale prospectus to get an idea on extension viability. Interest will not be applied to advertised volume hauled after the original expiration date. All other contractual requirements shall be and will remain in full force and effect.

A key will be required to gain access to the timber sale area.

All bids will be dropped off at the new location, Salem ODF office, Building E.

Work Order contract 341-21-13 "Mid Santiam Road Repair" will be concurrently operating within the term of this contract. This contract will be clearing and repairing roads to a pre-fire condition. Expiration date of this contract 5/31/21.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

This sale was covered by annual northern spotted owl density surveys since 2016 using protocols endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service^{1,2}. Northern spotted owls were not observed within 1.2 miles of this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Northern spotted owl survey results will not expire unless density surveys are discontinued. If density surveys are discontinued at any point during the contract, survey coverage will be valid until March 15, three years following the last full season of surveys.

Future Survey Plans

This sale will be covered by density surveys during the life of the contract. These density surveys provide incidental survey coverage in lieu of spot checks. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required. In addition, ODF has an active northern spotted owl survey program and density surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Spotted owl activity center monitoring may occur if this sale is within 3 miles of a known resident owl site.
