ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE

STATEMENT:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state

Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues. ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

NO PERSONAL OR COMPANY CHECKS ACCEPTED FOR THE BID DEPOSIT. SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SECTION 2455.

Pulp removal is required unless otherwise approved in writing by STATE.

Sale acreage was determined using GIS.

"Log Accountability" (Section 2015): "Log Measurement" (Section 2020): Log Branding and Painting" (Section 2030; and Exhibit C contain special language for pulp removal.

Log hauling on Kansas Creek Road is restricted to 4 loads per day between March 1 and October 31 during periods of rain equal to or greater than one half inches in a 24 hour period. STATE may allow additional loads a day when in the opinion of STATE, there is little risk for damage to resources or infrastructure (Sections 2035 and 2455).

Log hauling on Kansas Creek Road is not allowed between November 1 and February 28 (Sections 2035 and 2455).

Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls in Units 1, 2, and 3 and marbled murrelets in Unit 1. Unit 4 does not contain habitat for either species.

Survey Results

This sale was covered by spotted owl density surveys starting in in 2018^{1,2,3}. There have been no spotted owl observations within 1.5 miles of this sale during these surveys. Density surveys will be ongoing during the life of the sale contract.

Unit 1 was surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2019 and 2020, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group⁴. Marbled murrelets were not detected during any year of surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas or spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Northern spotted owl survey results will not expire unless density surveys are discontinued. If density surveys are discontinued at any point during the contract, survey coverage will be valid until March 15, three years following the last full season of surveys.

Work on the Fox Creek Ridge Road daylighting is not allowed from April 1st through August 5th. From August 6th through September 15th, work can only occur between 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset. These restrictions apply for every year of the sale life.

Marbled murrelet survey results for Unit1 are valid until April 1, 2026.

All timber in Unit 1 should be felled by April 1, 2026.

Future Survey Plans

This sale will be covered by northern spotted owl density surveys during the life of the contract. These density surveys provide incidental survey coverage in lieu of spot checks. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required. In addition, ODF has an active northern spotted owl survey program and surveys for other planned operations and density surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
