ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE

STATEMENT:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state

Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues. ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

ODF will modify timber sale contracts to allow purchasers who harvest after HCP permit issuance (expected in 2022) to harvest either (1) under requirements pre HCP to avoid take of listed species or (2) under the new requirements of the HCP, as applicable to each timber sale. If a purchaser chooses to harvest consistent with the requirements of the HCP, it will be the responsibility of the purchaser to comply with the HCP and permits, with assistance from and approval by ODF.

A midpoint payment of 50% is due by 10/23/2023.

All felling on all units must be complete by March 15, 2025 (Sections 2310, 2455).

Pulp removal is required unless otherwise approved in writing by STATE.

Sale acreage was determined using GIS.

Project #3 is an Optional Project to build a road and landing to facilitate yarding.

# **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets within and adjacent to all units.

# Survey Results

All sale units have been covered by a combination of ongoing northern spotted owl operational and density surveys beginning in 2018<sup>1,2,3</sup>. Northern spotted owls have not been observed during these surveys to date. Operational surveys will continue in 2022 to extend the contract felling date. Density surveys will be ongoing during the life of the sale contract.

This sale was surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2019, 2020 and 2021. These surveys were conducted using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>2</sup>. Marbled murrelets were not detected during any year of surveys.

### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale.

# **Operational Considerations**

Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2022 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2025 upon the completion of 2022 surveys.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2025.

Marbled Murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2027.

# **Future Survey Plans**

All sale units have been covered by a combination of northern spotted owl density surveys and operational surveys. Spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required for two consecutive years following the cessation of operational surveys outside of density compartments. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required for the entirety of the timber sale. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and surveys for other planned operations and northern spotted owl operational and density surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
