Follow the Aldercrest Rd 9/10ths of a mile to the gate on the Prairie Hill Rd. Follow the Prairie Hill Rd behind the gate for 9/10ths of a mile to the start of Unit 1. Continue through Unit 1 on the Prairie Hill Rd, approximately 2 miles behind the gate, to the start of Unit 2. Continue through Unit 2, approximately 2.5 miles behind the gate, to Unit 3.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE

STATEMENT:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state

Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues. ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

ODF will modify timber sale contracts to allow purchasers who harvest after HCP permit issuance (expected in 2022) to harvest either (1) under requirements pre HCP to avoid take of listed species or (2) under the new requirements of the HCP, as applicable to each timber sale. If a purchaser chooses to harvest consistent with the requirements of the HCP, it will be the responsibility of the purchaser to comply with the HCP and permits, with assistance from and approval by ODF.

Pulp removal is required unless otherwise approved in writing by STATE.

"Log Accountability" (Section 2015), "Log Measurement" (Section 2020), "Log Branding and Painting" (Section 2030), and Exhibit 'C' contain special language for pulp removal.

This sale contains downed timber resulting from multiple weather events from September of 2020 to February of 2021. The downed timber is a combination of broken tops and whole tree tip overs. There is approximately 5 acres of windthrown timber across the three sale Units.

A locked gate is located at the start of the Prairie Hill Road. Operators will need to obtain a combination or key to access the gate and will be responsible for ensuring the gate is closed at all times.

Transmission lines are located directly adjacent to the west side of Unit 1. Coordination with Pacific Power will be required for all activities near the transmission lines and easement (Section 2420).

The information shown on the Exhibit A map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

## Survey Results

This sale was covered by ongoing northern spotted owl operational surveys starting in 2020<sup>1</sup>,<sup>2</sup>,<sup>3</sup>. Northern spotted owls have not been observed during these surveys.

Marbled murrelet surveys are not required for this sale.

### Known T&E Resources

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas or spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Northern spotted owl spot checks surveys will occur beginning in 2022. Due to the presence of barred owls, felling restrictions for spotted owl spot check surveys are not required for this sale at this time.

Northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2024.

# **Future Survey Plans**

Focused spotted owl spot check surveys for this timber sale will be required in 2022 and 2023. ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl activity center monitoring will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
