Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. In some cases, ODF may require that initiation of operations be delayed to allow for completion of spot check surveys, as recommended by the USFWS survey protocol and required by ODF policy. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Also, legal challenges and other litigation regarding ODF threatened and endangered species related processes may occur and may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, or efforts are required to respond to legal issues. ODF will modify timber sale contracts to allow purchasers who harvest after HCP permit issuance (expected in 2022) to harvest either (1) under requirements pre HCP to avoid take of listed species or (2) under the new requirements of the HCP, as applicable to each timber sale. If a purchaser chooses to harvest consistent with the requirements of the HCP, it will be the responsibility of the purchaser to comply with the HCP and permits, with assistance from and approval by ODF.

### SPECIAL REMARKS: NO PERSONAL OR COMPANY CHECKS ACCEPTED FOR THE BID DEPOSIT. SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SECTION 2455.

Timber Sale Operations are restricted to May 1 through October 31 unless otherwise approved by STATE.

Log Hauling shall not be allowed on East Creek Road from November 1 through April 30 (Section 2035, Section 2120).

Log hauling shall not be allowed on Detrick Ranch road from October 16 through May 31 (Section 2035, Section 2120).

Purchaser shall secure pre-haul agreements for hauling across BLM, USFS, and Greenwood properties. Copies of sample agreements are available at the Tillamook District Office.

Purchaser should be aware Tillamook County may have an extensive repair project scheduled for summer 2023 on East Creek Road. Contact Tillamook County for more details.

## **Habitat Suitability**

There is potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets within or adjacent to all sale units.

## **Survey Results**

All sale units have been covered by spotted owl density surveys in 2020 and 2021<sup>1,2,3</sup>. Northern spotted owls were observed within 1.5 miles of this sale during these surveys on two occasions during same visit in 2021. An unknown Strix owl was detected within 1.5 miles of this sale on one occasion in 2021. Currently, the observations of northern spotted owls do not me the requirements for residency. Density surveys will be ongoing during the life of the sale contract.

This sale was surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2019 and 2020, and 2020 and 2021. These surveys were conducted using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>4</sup>. Marbled murrelets have not been detected during these surveys to date.

## Known T&E Resources

A portion of this sale is within the outer home range of the Moon Creek East northern spotted owl site. Less than 5 acres of potential habitat will be removed. By ODF policy<sup>1</sup>, a Biological Assessment is not required.

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale.

## **Operational Considerations**

This sale is in a density survey coverage area. Northern spotted owl felling deadlines for survey expirations will not be in effect unless density surveys are discontinued. If density surveys are discontinued at any point during the contract, survey coverage will be valid until March 15, three years following the last full season of surveys.

Marbled murrelet surveys will be valid until April 1, 2027 for Unit 1, and April 1, 2026 for Units 2, 3, 4, 5. Marbled murrelet surveys will not be required for Unit 6 road work, as long as felling for the Eastern Moon sale has occurred by 4/1/2023.

All timber should be felled by April 1, 2027 for Unit 1 and 4/1/2026 for Units 2, 3, 4, and 5.

## **Future Survey Plans**

This sale will be covered by northern spotted owl density surveys during the life of the contract. These density surveys provide incidental survey coverage in lieu of spot checks. If density surveys are not conducted, then spot checks will be required. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and surveys for other planned operations, northern spotted owl density surveys, and activity center monitoring will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
