The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Habitat Suitability

Areas adjacent to this sale contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Northern spotted owl and marbled murrelet surveys are not required for this sale because the timber was felled and decked during fire protection efforts. No additional timber felling is required for this salvage.

Known T&E Resources

Portions of this sale are within the Doty Hill Marbled Murrelet Management Area.

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Work on this sale is not allowed from April 1st through August 5th. From August 6th through September 15th, work can only occur between 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset. These restrictions apply for every year of the sale life.

Future Survey Plans

There are no planned surveys within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
