Habitat Suitability

This ice storm damage salvage sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets but is within 100 meters of unsurveyed potential habitat. A survey waiver has been prepared by the Area Biologist and documents required protection measures.

Survey Results

This sale does not require northern spotted owl operational surveys^{1,2}.

In lieu of surveys, a Survey Waiver for marbled murrelets has been prepared for this sale with required protection measures for potential habitat adjacent to the sale.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is not within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. Portions of this sale fall within a non-baseline thiessen and elevated baseline thiessen as identified in the Safe Harbor Agreement (SHA) with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS). Operations within an elevated baseline thiessen require preparation of a habitat

assessment. A habitat assessment has been prepared for this sale and outlines specific protection measures to protect unsurveyed potential habitat.

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Felling and road reconstruction restrictions are in place for portions of the timber sale within 100 meters of potential murrelet habitat patch west of the sale. No felling or road reconstruction in this buffer is permitted until after September 15, 2024.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has entered into an agreement with the USFWS known as a SHA. This agreement allows the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) to conduct a study on ODF managed lands which includes population reduction measures on barred owls to assess the impacts on northern spotted owls. This Contract contains sale areas within the USGS study boundary. Under this agreement, if nesting northern spotted owls are found in or within close proximity of the timber sale, the nest and surrounding area would be protected until fledglings leave the nest utilizing seasonal restrictions and other measures. In addition, ODF may take other actions including retaining and protecting trees in the immediate area of a nest tree.

ODF has an active survey program. Surveys for other planned operations, northern spotted owl operational surveys, spot check surveys and activity center monitoring may be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
