### Habitat Suitability

This ice storm damage salvage sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets.

### **Survey Results**

Surveys for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets are not required for this sale.

### Known T&E Resources

This sale is not within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center nor is it within the Safe Harbor Agreement (SHA) with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS).

This sale is not within 100 meters of potential murrelet habitat and there are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA) affecting this sale.

## **Operational Considerations**

There are no operational considerations for protecting T&E resources associated with this salvage sale.

### **Future Survey Plans**

ODF has an active survey program. Surveys for other planned operations, northern spotted owl operational surveys, spot check surveys and activity center monitoring may be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
